INFORMATION

Following is a list of basic information about Berks, Bassmasters membership and activities. If you are still interested in becoming a member after reading this, please fill out the membership application and mail it to me as soon as possible. Please read the requirements of membership carefully, as we strictly enforce them due to the fact that we maintain a waiting list of people wanting to become members. The reason there is a waiting list is that our Club Charter only allows thirty (30) members at one time. We have a turnover of 3 or 4 new members each year due to members resigning for various personal reasons. As soon as your application is received your name will be placed on the waiting list. Please be patient, if you wish to know where you are on the waiting list, feel free to give me a call after you mail in your application.

Basic Rules of Membership

1. Annual Club Dues are \$100.00 per year payable on 12/1. (\$55.00 pays National & State dues, \$45.00 pays club dues). If you join during the tournament season (April thru October) dues will be \$75.00 payable upon membership acceptance and \$75.00 will be due the following 12/1.
2. Each active member must participate in 50% of club functions. Club functions include monthly tournaments, annual Club Flea Market, Blue Marsh structure projects, annual Buddy Tournaments and any other activity designated as a club function.
3. Each active member must THE Bass FEDERATION INC upon becoming a member of Berks Bassmasters. There is a onetime \$5.00 fee for this.
4. Each member must be 16 years of age or older.

Club Activities

1. Annual Ladies Night and Awards Banquet (usually in February or March).
2. Annual Sportsman's Flea Market (usually in January).
3. Annual Open Buddy Tournament (usually in April & October).
4. Monthly meetings are held the first Wednesday of every month at the North End Rod & Gun Assn. starting at 7:30 PM.
5. We usually schedule 10 to 12 club tournaments (for club members only) each year in various locations in Eastern PA and a few outside of PA. Some locations are; Susquehanna Flats, Delaware River, Beltsville Lake, Blue Marsh Lake, Lake Wallenpaupack, St Lawrence River, Lake Oneida and the Potomac River.
6. Blue Marsh Structure Projects are periodic work details organized at Blue Marsh in order to improve the fish habitat and hopefully the fishing.
